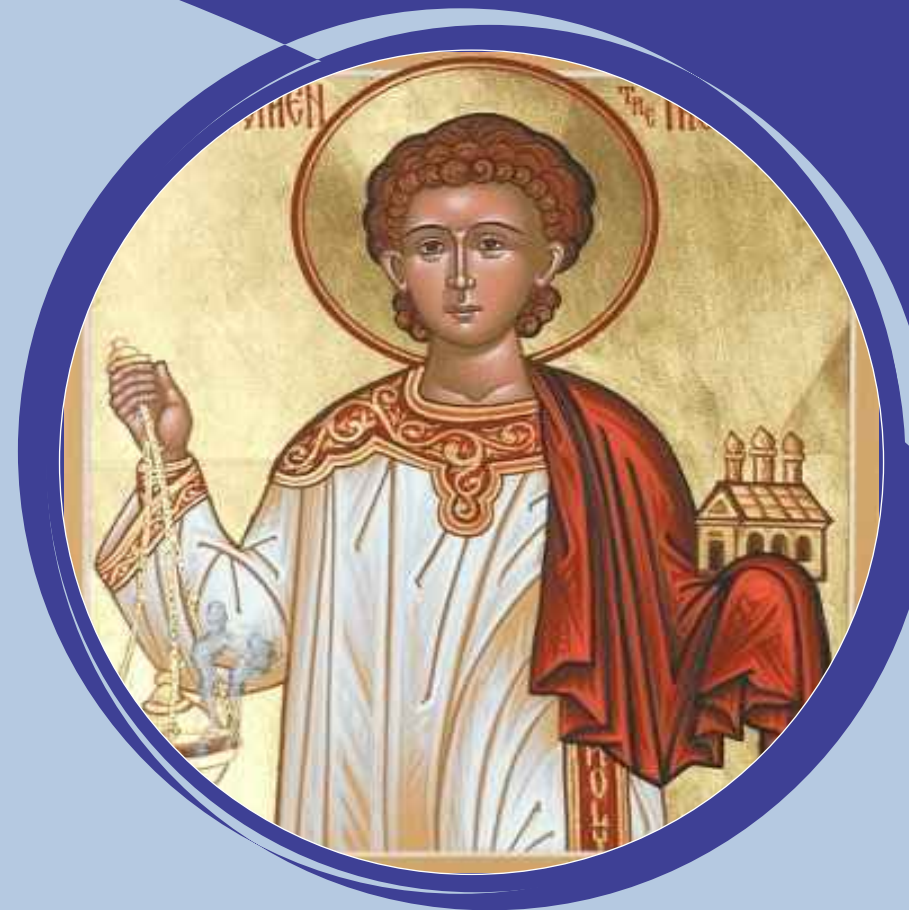


Duly filled in Application Forms along with necessary attachments should be dropped into the School's Submission Box. The mailing addresses are as follows :

2. The School will not be responsible if an application is received after the last date of submission of application form. Application will be received by hand or any other medium. No telephonic queries regarding any admission matters will be entertained by any School personnel. The School will not be responsible for mis-information or mis-interpretation or any verbal queries from any school personnel or by any person claiming to act on behalf of the School Authorities. In case more than one application for the same candidate are received, all applications of such candidates will be rejected.

4. Photocopy of birth Certificate from Panchayat / Corporation / Municipality / State Hospital or an affidavit is to be enclosed. The photocopy must be duly attested by a competent authority. Photo copy of Aadhar Card.
5. Christian candidates must submit a photocopy of Baptism Certificate duly attested by the Presbyterian-in-charge/Parish Priest, along with a bonafide membership certificate and evidence of up-to-date clearance of church dues.
6. The Certificates of Income of Parents/Guardians, if applicable are to be attached. Those who are self employed or who have their own business must submit a personal statement of their yearly income along with a photocopy of PAN CARD & INCOME TAX RETURN.
7. Selected candidates for Admission will notified by post, individually. No list of candidates will be published.
8. The school authority reserves the right to reject any application without giving any reasons. No enquiries regarding rejection of any applications will be entertained.
9. Candidates seeking admission for Class K.G. onwards will be required to submit a Transfer Certificate from his/her previous school at the time of admission, if selected.

St. Stephen The Patron Saint

The school derives its name from St. Stephen, the first Christian Martyr, who is regarded as the Patron Saint of the institution and 15th of February is celebrated as St. Stephen's or The Founder's Day. St. Stephen is portrayed in glowing terms in the Book of Acts, Chapters 6 & 7 of the Bible. Stephen was a not only wise but also a person of profound faith. God blessed him richly and he was filled with the Holy Spirit. He performed many miracles and went about spreading the message of God. However, some men from Cyrene and Alexandria who were members of a group called "Free Men". They began to argue with Stephen and were joined in by other from Cilicia and Asia. They were no match with Stephen who spoke with wisdom that the Holy Spirit had bestowed upon him. They influence the teacher of the Law of Moses, had Stephen arrested and brought before the Sanhedrin. There were false allegations made against him that he was talking against the Laws of Moses and saying that Jesus of Nazareth would destroy everything and change customs that Moses had given. When asked if the allegations were true he spoke boldly against the evil practices of the Jewish leaders and warned the people about their rejection of God's messengers and disobeying of God's laws. The preaching of Stephen was not appreciated by the members of the Jewish Council who became furious and gnashed their teeth in anger and when he said that he could see Jesus standing in all his glory at the right hand of God, they yelled at the so-called abomination, dragged him out of the city and stoned him to death. In the likeness of his master he, too, at the time of his death, cried out for the forgiveness of all those who had tormented and killed him. St. Stephen is a glowing example of spiritual leadership. Even at a very young age he had faith, wisdom, courage, love, forgiveness, humility and, above all, he had been inspired by the Holy Spirit. He stands as an outstanding witness of Christ and a radiant martyr for the cause of Mission. We sincerely hope that the life of St. Stephen will inspire all young men and women, who come under our tutelage, because they are "STEPHENITES".

School Rules



1. Punctuality is a prime importance and latecomers will not be granted without the permission of the Principal/Vice principal/Incharge.
2. Attendance norms, as per the Council regulation, is 75% in order to qualify for the Board Examination and those below 65% do not qualify for promotion.
3. Absentees for 7 consecutive days, without proper notice, will be liable to have their names removed from the register.
4. Science student who do not attend the theory classes regularly shall not be permitted to attend the practical classes.
5. Students must carry their Student's Identity Cards in the school campus. If an ID Card is lost, a duplicate one can be obtained with the permission of the Principal or his deputy and on payment of a fine.
6. Students are expected tolerate every member of the staff and fellow students with courtesy both inside and outside of the school. No form of indiscipline shall be tolerated and any indifference, in this regard, may lead to serious consequences.
7. Students must be in their respective class rooms and at their seats at the beginning of each period. They must not enter or leave the classroom without permission.



8. School property, furniture, library books must be used or handled with care.
9. Any damage to the same shall attract a fine.
10. Smoking, chewing tobacco products, spitting and aimlessly loitering around the campus shall attract disciplinary action.
11. Rules for the conduct of Examinations, placed on the Notice Board, must be strictly adhered to. Impersonation of roll calls is a punishable offence.

ADMISSION PROCEDURE



St. Stephen's Group of School are following ICSE curriculum the academic Session 2022-2023 will commence on and from 2nd Week of April 2022



Application for admission is to be made in the prescribed form available along with the prospectus issued as per the school notice during September.

Detailed information regarding admissions may be obtained from the notice board from the month of August. Information may also be obtained from the school office but not over telephone. Admissions are usually carried out for the Nursery classes. K.G., on first-come first served basis of candidates fulfilling basic criteria. It is expected that all information provided in the forms should be accurate because any subsequent change shall not be permitted and should any false information be detected, the said application shall be rejected. It is imperative that in order to qualify for admission into the Lower Nursery class a child should have attained 3+ years of age on 1st April, 2022 the year of admission.

Short listed candidates are called for interview / admission tests. Candidates are examined in the basis of the attained standards in the previous grade of the class into which admission is sought. During interview both the parents are expected to attend. The final step for admission will be the filling in of the Admission Form. All the data provided ought to be accurate and any discrepancy, in this regard, shall go against the candidate's rights of admission. Prospective parents / guardians are advised not to fall prey to touts or any such person or person claiming to be representative of the School Authorities. The school shall not be held responsible should any individual fall prey to any such adverse situation.
